

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In Daisies we will be focusing on confidence in sharing news and what they have been doing at home or school.

Activities Planned include:

- Talking about our friends that we are making and encouraging them to join in with their play.
- We will be talking about our emotions and how we are feeling. We will then discuss how we can calm ourselves.
- We will be talking about being kind to each other and using kind hands. The children will be making each other a kindness rosette.
- We will be learning about differences between each other such as hair colour or eye colour.
- We will be doing some mindfulness activities such as mindful walks and Yoga.

Early Reading

Detailed story sessions daily with questioning. What do you think is going to happen? Where are they going? Who can you see? What happens next?

Text Focus – The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Oliver's Vegetables.

Beginning name recognition – Self-registration.

We will be looking at our favourite books in the school Library in Daisies.

Communication and Language

In Daisies will be working on sitting and joining in with focus activities for a couple of minutes.

We are working on our confidence with sharing news to a small group of our friends.

Activities planned include:

- Lola says (Following actions Lola says can you find your eyes.)
- Nursery rhymes and singing action songs.
- Word Aware – developing our vocabulary and language; Small, Long, Fat, Thin, Heavy Light.
- Joining in with refrains from familiar stories and predict what might happen next.
- Sharing news to small groups of friends.
- Developing our understanding and knowledge on a lifecycle.

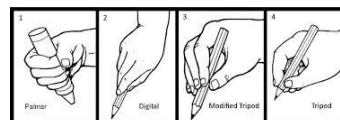
Large scale chalk drawing.
