

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In Daisies we will be focusing on talking about feelings and emotions, some of the boundaries and our wellbeing.

Activities Planned include:

- Talking about our friends that we are making and encouraging them to join in with their play.
- Making our own choices in creative activities. (What colour paint they would like to use)
- We will be talking about being kind to each other and using kind hands.
- We will be learning about sharing and how we make each other feel.
- We will be doing some mindfulness activities such as Yoga and being in the outdoors.
- Create a friendship circle.
- To make Nursery Rhyme hand puppets.

## Early Reading

Detailed story sessions daily with questioning. What do you think is going to happen? Where are they going? Who can you see? What happens next?

Nursery rhymes – Old Mac Donald Had a Farm, Wheels on the Bus and 5 Little Ducks.

A variety of nursery rhyme sacks will be sent home on a regular basis (COVID safe)

Print in the environment, Logos and books, displays.

## Communication and Language

In Daisies will be working on sitting and joining in with focus activities for a couple of minutes.

We are working on following simple instructions such as can you tidy the books away.

Activities planned include:

- Lola says (Following actions Lola says can you find your eyes.)
- Instrument sounds (choosing the instruments to match the correct sound)
- Nursery rhymes and singing action songs.
- Looking at pictures and talking about what they see.
- Word Aware – developing our vocabulary and language; soft, rough, fast, slow, loud and quiet.
- Joining in with refrains from familiar stories.
