- We will be talking about being kind to each other and using kind hands.
- We will be learning about sharing and how we make each other feel.
- We will be doing some mindfulness activities such as Yoga and being in the outdoors.

## Communication and Language

In Daisies will be working on sitting and joining in with focus activities for a couple of minutes.

We will also be working on our language and introducing 2 to 3 new words a week for the children to learn.

We are working on following simple instructions such as can you tidy the books away.

Activities planned include:

- Lola says (Following actions Lola says can you find your eyes.)
- Animal bag (picking an animal out the bag and saying the animal and the sound)
- Nursery rhymes and singing action songs.
- Looking at pictures and talking about what they see.
